Joining the Thickwood Hills Studio Trail (Amended May 2024)

The applicant must have a residence or studio within the boundaries of the studio trail map. (Please refer to map.)

The art must be original, and created by the artisan.

Application forms are available at www.thickwoodhillsstudiotrail.com or from committee members; completed forms should be submitted online or to a committee member.

There is a \$100.00 fee for joining, as well as an annual fee set at the September meeting.

Applicants will be vetted by at least 3 members of the committee.

The decision will be based on the quality and originality of the work and the ambience of the studio or place in which the artist will show. "Will they enhance our tour?" The applicant must be a working artist, able to create enough pieces for a 2 day show and sale.

Applicants who wish to participate in the studio trail the following year, must apply to the committee by November 1 of the current year, and be vetted by November 15, to allow for inclusion in the brochure.

Once an applicant has been vetted they will be notified of the committee's decision via email.
